Cambridge Pre-U

- Prepares learners, typically aged 16 to 19, with the skills and knowledge they need to make a success of their studies at university
- Available in 25 Principal Subjects
- Two-year courses with exams at the end
- One-year Short Courses also available
- Recognised by many UK universities and all US Ivy League universities
- Mainly taken by UK schools as an alternative to A Level







Cambridge Pre-U Global Perspectives and Research (GPR)

- Develops critical thinking and research skills
- First year: Global Perspectives
 - students research and explore a wide range of global topics
- Second year: Research Report
 - students prepare an extended project, digging deeply into one topic
- Being taught in schools around the world to broaden students' learning
